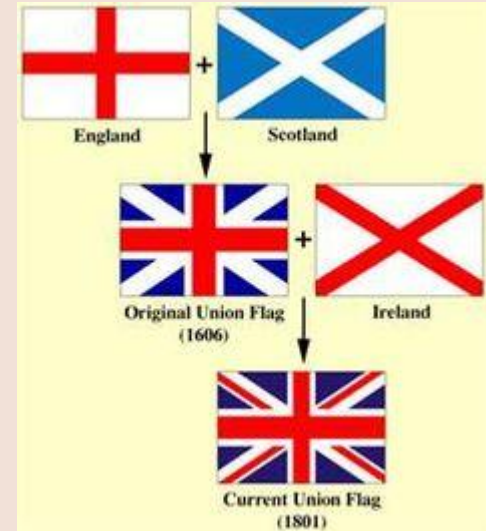
Who is King James the first?

- He introduced a new flag representing both England and Scotland in 12th April 1606.



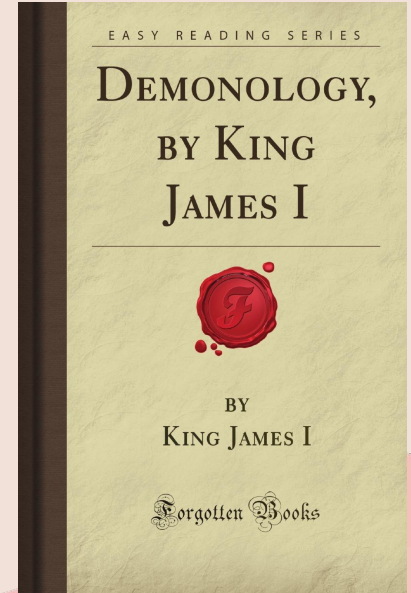
What is he famous for?
